

ADDITIONAL RENTAL CONDITIONS

KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE

The renter guarantees that they have sufficient knowledge and experience to properly navigate and skipper the ship. They must also comply with all legal requirements for operating the rented ship. If the lessor determines that the renter, in their judgment, does not possess the required knowledge and experience, they have the right to refuse permission for the renter to leave the marina. Only when the lessor determines that the renter has sufficient knowledge to safely navigate and maneuver the ship, may the renter leave the marina on their own.

The renter who does not meet the requirement of sufficient knowledge and experience is not entitled to a refund of the rental fee.

ALLOWED NAVIGATION WATERS

The renter is only allowed to sail the ship on all Dutch inland waters, the IJsselmeer (provided there is experience and weather conditions permit), and the Wadden Sea (provided there is experience and weather conditions permit). With prior agreement with the lessor, sailing in the German Wadden Sea is allowed.

ALLOWED WEATHER CONDITIONS

The hirer is obliged to always take the current weather conditions into account when sailing and to anticipate any expected changes. Under no circumstances is sailing permitted in wind speeds above force 5 on the Beaufort scale and/or poor visibility. Insufficient or unfavourable weather conditions do not constitute grounds for free cancellation or postponement of the rental period.

MARIFOON

If the ship is equipped with a marine radio, its use is reserved for crew members who hold a valid operating certificate. The renter is responsible for any communication costs associated with the use of the marine radio.

BREAKDOWNS AND EMERGENCIES AT SEA

The lessor will do their best to prevent breakdowns and emergencies. However, if an emergency does occur, the renter must contact the lessor immediately. Together, they will attempt to resolve any issues as quickly as possible.

DAMAGE

If damage occurs to the ship and/or equipment during the rental period, the renter must **immediately** report it by phone to the lessor. A solution will be sought in consultation to ensure the holiday can continue as soon as possible.

PETS

No pets are allowed on board the ship.

INSTRUCTION

Upon departure, the renter is entitled to a short, free instruction. Additional, longer instruction is available upon request for a reasonable fee.

DEPARTURE

Upon departure, the ship is cleaned, inspected, and filled with a full tank of fuel. Always inspect the ship for any damage before departure and report any damage prior to setting sail.

ARRIVAL

At the time specified in the rental agreement, the ship must be returned to the marina in a **clean condition, with a full fuel tank, an empty waste water tank**, and ready for inspection and handover to the lessor. Our team is available on changeover days until 09:30 for check-out, so it is crucial that you return the ship on time. Late returns will incur a charge of €50 per quarter hour.

GROUNDING

The renter is responsible for selecting a suitable position for grounding the ship. They must consider factors such as wind, the seabed, and waves. Tornado Sailing Makkum B.V. explicitly emphasizes that grounding on the Green Beach at Terschelling and the beach west of Vlieland is **prohibited** due to the wave action caused by passing ferries..
